AND NOW, after consideration of the Status Report and Joint Motion for Modification of the Scheduling Order, it is hereby:


ORDERED that the United States will provide, on a rolling basis, ending no later than February 28, 2021, declarations from individuals with knowledge of each of the eight Department in the IRS's Return Preparer Office detailing the responsibilities, personnel, and estimates of time spent on certain tasks for each Department for the period 2010-2017; and it is further

ORDERED that all fact depositions relating to the 2010-2017 period will be completed by April 30, 2021; and it is further

ORDERED that by March 31, 2021, the parties will submit a proposed schedule for the balance of the case, including expert reports and discovery (if any), summary judgment and trial.
