NOTICE OF PARTIAL WITHDRAWAL AND ERRATA

Upon further review of the stipulation filed on November 13, 2020 (Doc. No. 144), the Government has determined it cannot move for Summary Judgment as to the current PTIN fee at this stage in the proceedings. The Government therefore withdraws its request for relief as to the current PTIN fee and is submitting an updated Memorandum in Support of Summary Judgment and proposed Order to remove this relief. However, this partial withdrawal does not impact the methodology or analysis in the Government’s memorandum, and the Government will address the current PTIN fee later, as agreed upon in the stipulation.
